Upon consideration of the "Brief and Required Short Appendix of Petitioners, Minisink Residents for Preservation of the Environment and Safety," construed as a request for emergency relief under the All Writs Act, it is

ORDERED, on the court's own motion, that the Order Issuing Certificate, FERC Docket No. CP11-515-000, filed July 17, 2012, and the order approving commencement of construction, filed September 18, 2012, be stayed pending further order of the court. The purpose of this administrative stay is to give the court sufficient opportunity to consider the merits of the request for emergency relief under the All Writs Act, and should not be construed in any way as a ruling on the merits of that motion. See D.C. Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures 32 (2011). It is

FURTHER ORDERED, on the court's own motion, that respondent file a response to the emergency request by 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 9, 2012, and that petitioners file any reply by 12:00 noon, Wednesday, October 10, 2012. The parties are directed to hand-deliver the paper copies of their submissions to the court by the time and date due.
